However, Technical Section, IFD section of MHRD and Prof. Somanath Maji had given a written a comments on the agenda items which were taken into consideration during the course of the meeting.

Item No. 13.01:

Confirmation of the Minutes of the 12th Meeting of the Board of Governors (BoG) of CIT held on 3rdJune,2016.

The Minutes of the 12th Meeting of the BoG held on 3rdJune, 2016 was circulated amongst the members. The members were requested to place comments if any for consideration. As we have not received any comments, the Board considered the Minutes confirmed.

Item No. 13.02:

Action taken Report (ATR) on the Resolutions of the 12th Meeting of the BoG.

Item No.13.04:

To consider the Minutes of the 12th Finance Committee held on 27th February, 2017.

Item No.13.05:

Proposal for granting on Scale for contract faculty.

CIT had already filled up the post for Professor and Associate Professors positions as sanctioned by the MHRD. However, if the departments feel that they require guest/contract faculty for lien vacancies and general vacancies, it is proposed that such faculty may be placed in scale of pay relating to qualification and experience.

**Resolution:** The members of the Board commented that the remuneration/honorarium of contractual faculty should be in consolidated form.

Item No.13.06: Proposal for adoption of 7th Pay Commission.

The 7th pay commission recommendation by GOI may be adopted and implementation exercise be initiated subject to receipt of order from Ministry of HRD.

Resolution: The matter is subject to Ministry's Notification.

Item No.13.07:

Proposal for implementation of complete IT Solution/ERP in CFTIs (SLIET, CIT & GKCIET).

In compliance to the decision taken in the 10th BoGMeeting agenda no. the institute had initiated the process of floating EOI; which was published on 29th June2016 in National Dailies. In response to it we had received only two participants. As per GFR 2005, the no.of participants should not be less than 3. Hence the committee decided to repeat the exercise. Meantime, a meeting was conducted by Dr.D.K. Paliwal, DEA (T), MHRD, New Delhi on 18/07/2016. In the said meeting time schedule for finalization of RFP was submitted by all the CFTI's. The CFTI'shad also nominated members for constituting of Technical Committee and Purchase Committee for the purpose. In compliance to the decision taken in the meeting on 18.07.2016, consent was taken from all the CFTI's and SLIET Longowal was made the Coordinator for floating of EOI with respect to ERP Solutions for all four CFTI's. One or two members would be co-opted if required.

Thereafter, an EOI was published in leading News Paper on 18/10/2016 for implementation of complete IT solutions at CFTIs. As per requirement of EOI technical presentations from bidders was taken on 21st November 2016 in the committee room at SLIET. In the said presentation, only two parties appeared for technical presentation. As per GFR 2005, the number of shortlisted consultant should not be less than three, therefore, the committee recommended for further re-advertisement for preparation of SRS() and ERP software's for the CFTIs.

EOI was again floated in the leading New Paper on 03/12/2016 for appointment of consultant for the preparation of request for proposal (RFP) & software requirement specifications (SRS) .The Technical bids of the following parties were opened as per scheduled:

- Mr. Amit Kumar, Stratospher IT services Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi.
- 2. Mr. Hardeep Kaur, Telecommunications Consultants India Ltd., New Delhi.
- 3. Mr. K. Narayanan IIT Delhi, New Delhi.
- 4. M/s Capstart Consulting, Mumbai.
- 5. Mr. A.K.Batta, Mani, Majra, Chandigarh.

The technical bids of the above-mentioned five parties were opened on 20/12/2016. On technical evaluation it was found that only one party i.e. M/s Telecommunications Consultants India Ltd., New Delhi was technically qualified. Again as per GFR 2005 Rule 176 the committee has given justification. However, when the financial bid was open it was noted that the firm had quoted at a very high rate. However, the firm was invited for negotiation. As the firm was not ready to review the rates it was cancelled and fresh rates from the other four parties were invited.

Thereafter, it was found that A.K.Batta, Mani, Majra, Chandigarh had quote the lowest rate of Rs. 6,00,000/- plus other charges based on actual expenditure. It was further intimated by SLIET that work order for Engagement/Appointment of consultant for preparation of RFP & SRS for implementation of complete has been issued to Mr. A.K.Batta, Mani, Majra, Chandigarh on the approval of its BoM.

Now, it is proposed that the members may consider and approve the engagement/appointment of Mr. A.K.Batta, Mani, Majra, Chandigarh as consultant for preparation of RFP & SRS for implementation IT solution for CIT Kokrajhar.

Resolution: The matter is considered by the Board in principle.

#### Item No.13.08:

## Proposal for transfer of vacant position.

- a. At present CIT has no System Administrator in order to manage the networking System. We are badly in need of one post of System Administrator. The said post will be manned by transferring one vacant position of Office Superintendent.
- b. There is one vacant sanctioned post of Pharmacist, however the Institute feels the Pharmacist post is not required right nowas we do not have full-fledged health centre. Hence, itis proposed that the said post of pharmacist may be transfer to Jr. Accountant, which is urgently needed to cop up the work of the accounts section. As these positions are made through transfer and within the sanction strength there will be no additional financial implications.
