Section A: Confirmation of Minutes

Item No. 13.01: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 12th Meeting of the Senate of CIT Kokrajhar held on 24th February, 2022 through online mode.

Section B: Items requiring approval of the Senate

Item No. 13.02: Proposal for awarding Diploma and PG Degrees to graduating students of various batches.

A. Diploma in various disciplines to the students admitted in the academic year 2019-20.

The results for the 1st batches of students of various Diploma programmes of the institute admitted in the academic year 2019-20 was prepared by the examination cell (Deemed to be University section). The list of students found eligible to be awarded the Diploma as per the current academic regulations was placed before the meeting.

B. M. Tech and M. Des Degree to the students admitted in the academic year 2020-21.

The results for the 2nd batch of students of various PG programmes of the institute admitted in the academic year 2020-21 was prepared by the examination cell (Deemed to be University section). The lists of students found eligible to be awarded the degree of M. Tech and M. Des as per the current PG regulations were placed in the meeting.

The members were requested to approve the proposal.

Resolution: The proposal was confirmed by the members.

Item No. 13.03: Proposal for awarding Degree of Doctor of Philosophy in various disciplines to the qualified students admitted in the January 2019 session.

As per the provisions of the institute's Ph.D. academic regulations (clause 23.1), after getting the recommendation of the Viva Voce Board, a student will be awarded the Ph.D. degree on the recommendation of the Senate with the approval of the Board of Governors (BoG) of the Institute.

The members were therefore requested to recommend the proposal to be forwarded to the BoG for the necessary approval.

Resolution: The members approved the proposal and recommend the same to be forwarded to the next meeting of the Board of Governors. It was also resolved that a provisional certificate would be issued to the scholars after successful completion of the viva voce examination (Defense) of their theses. In this regard it was suggested to prepare a proforma of the provisional certificate with the approval of the Chairman, Senate.

Item No. 13.04: Review of the amended draft of the Academic regulations for PhD programmes of the institute.

As per resolution no. 12.04 of the 12th Senate meeting of the institute held on 24th February 2022, the draft of the amended Ph.D. regulations of the institute were further reviewed to propose a fresh amended draft complete in all aspects by the same 3-member committee which was originally formed to review the existing Ph.D. regulations of the institute. The committee had prepared the amended draft of the regulations along with a comparative analysis of the same with the existing one. The drafts of the amended regulation and the comparative statement were placed before in the meeting.

The members were requested to provide their comments and approve the same.

Resolution: The members approved the proposed draft of the PhD regulations.

A. Pass certificate for PhD programme

The draft of the Degree certificate to be issued to the passed-out students of the PhD programmes of the institute was prepared in line with the proforma already in use for other programmes and was placed before the members.

B. Migration certificate.

Under the status of Deemed to be University, various batched of students have been graduating from the institute from the academic year 2020-2021. In view of this, a draft proforma of the said certificate to be issued to these graduating students of the institute was prepared and placed before the meeting.

Resolution: The members approved the proformas as proposed. Regarding the proforma of Pass certificate for PhD programme it was resolved that the title of the thesis should be included in the certificate.

Item No. 13.07:

Proposal for changing the nomenclature of the programme "Diploma in Animation and Multimedia Technology (AMT)" to "Diploma in Design".

In view of the poor admissions in the Diploma programme in AMT in past few years, the department of Multimedia Communication and Design (MCD) of the institute had submitted a proposal to change the nomenclature of the programme to "Diploma in Design". The institute is currently offering the Diploma in AMT programme under the domain of Engineering and Technology, although it is being run by the department of MCD. For taking admission into this programme the candidates need to appear in a common entrance test conducted for all other diploma programmes of Engineering and Technology domain.

In view of this from the next academic session, either the nomenclature of the programme may be changed to "Diploma in Design" under the Design domain subject to approval of the AICTE or a separate entrance test only for admission into the Diploma in AMT programme may be conducted.

The members were requested to provide their comments and approve the proposal.

Resolution: After threadbare discussion it was resolved that a separate entrance test only for admission into the Diploma programme in AMT would be conducted from the next session.
