# Item No. 17.03: Proposal for approval of the revised curricula and syllabi for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (1<sup>st</sup> year) courses of the Diploma, UG and PG programmes of the institute.

The institute is in a process of revision of the curricula and the syllabi of all the programmes of the institute in line with the National Educational Policy 2020 (NEP 2020). The revision of the curriculum for the 1<sup>st</sup> semesters of all the programmes has already been completed. Presently the revised drafts of the course structure and detailed syllabi of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester (1<sup>st</sup> year) courses of the Diploma, UG and PG programmes have been prepared by the concerned departments and placed in the meeting.

The members were requested to comment and approve the same.

Resolution: The course structure and syllabi of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester courses of the Diploma, UG and PG programmes were approved in principle with the mentioned modification.

- 1. The course structure and syllabi of all the courses shall be vetted by the Board of Studies of the respective departments.
- 2. Course files for each of the courses shall be maintained by the course instructors/faculty members.
- 3. Heads of the academic departments are to ensure the practice of maintaining course files by all the faculty members of the respective departments.
- 4. Dean of Academic Affairs was asked to send a common guideline about the components of the Course Files.

### Item No. 17.04: Proposal for approval of the revised PhD course works of the PhD programmes of all the departments.

The curriculum of the PhD course works of the PhD programmes of all the departments of the institute was revised. The drafts of the same were placed before the members.

The members were requested to comment and approve the same.

Resolution: The revised course structure and syllabi of the PhD course works were approved in principle with the following suggestions.

- 1. The course structure and syllabi shall be vetted by the Board of Studies of the respective departments.
- 2. The credit for the course "Research Methodology" of all the departments shall be 4 (L-T-P:3-1-0).

#### Item No. 17.05:

Proposal for inclusion of five new courses in the groups of elective courses in the 8<sup>th</sup> semester curriculum of the existing B. Tech programme in Instrumentation Engineering.

The department of Instrumentation Engineering of the institute proposed to introduce five new elective courses under the groups Elective I and Elective II in the 8<sup>th</sup> semester curriculum of its existing B. Tech programme. The detailed syllabi of the courses were placed before the members.

Members were requested to approve the same.

Resolution: The proposal for inclusion of the new elective courses was approved in principle with the following suggestions.

- 1. The syllabi of the courses shall be vetted by the Board of Studies of the concerned department.
- 2. The total contact hours of the referred courses shall be 36.
- 3. The unit wise distribution of contact hours is not necessary. Flexibility should be given to the course instructor to fix that distribution.

#### Item No. 17.06: Proposal for amendment of the PhD regulations of the institute.

With reference to the resolution no. 16.02 of the Minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting of the institute held on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2024, the draft of the amended PhD regulations of the institute was reviewed by the Institute PhD programme Committee (IPPC) considering the comments received from the members of the Senate and the academic departments of the institute. The clause wise amendments proposed by the IPPC on the amended draft of the PhD regulations were placed before the members.

Members were requested to comment and approve the amendments so that the draft of the revised PhD regulations could be finalised. Resolution: the proposed amendments were approved by the members with the following observations.

- 1. The revised regulation shall be applicable with effect from the date of the Senate meeting in which it is approved.
- 2. The regulations shall be applicable to all the scholars who have not yet submitted the PhD synopsis.
- 3. Content of the publications of any PhD scholar should be a part of his/her thesis.
- 4. Issues related to the acceptance of research publications of any PhD scholar shall be resolved with the approval of the Chairman, Senate on a case-to-case basis.

#### Item No. 17.07: Proposal for approval of the revised grading system of the institute.

With reference to the resolution no. 16.08 of the Minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting of the institute held on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2024, the institute proposed to modify the existing grading system of the institute. The draft of the revised grading system applicable for all the programmes was placed before the members. The said modifications shall be incorporated by amending the clause no. 7 of the Academic ordinance of the institute.

Members were requested to comment and approve the same.

Resolution: The proposal for the revised grading system was approved by the members with the following suggestions.

- 1. Make-up examination before the supplementary examinations shall be conducted for students absent in an examination due to genuine reasons as certified by the Course instructor and the respective Head of the department.
- 2. In case of courses with less than 10 students, Head of the concerned department is expected to monitor the grading process before finalisation of the grades.





### Item No. 17.10: Proposal for approval of requests of two PhD scholars for exemption of PhD Course works.

Two applications were received from the following students taking admission into the PhD programmes under the department of Chemistry and Civil Engineering of the institute in the current session (July, 2024) requesting for exemption of the Course works. The applications were forwarded by the Heads of the concerned departments. Both of them had successfully completed the course works of the PhD programmes earlier under the same departments of the institute. It is to be noted here that the students have taken admission afresh by withdrawing their earlier admission.

In view of the above, the students had requested to consider their earlier course works and to exempt them from doing the course works afresh.

The agenda item was discussed in the IPPC meeting held on 06-08-2024. The members of the IPPC approved the proposal in principle and recommended the same to be placed in the Senate meeting for approval of their request and to consider their completed course works in lieu of the Course works of their current PhD programmes. However, they will complete the 2-credit mandatory course "Research and Publication Ethics (PHS101)" that has been introduced from the current session as per the guidelines of UGC.

Members were requested to approve the proposal.

Resolution: After threadbare discussions, the members approved the request of Jackie Brahma to exempt from doing the course work again. However, the request of Phulung Brahma was not approved. Moreover, the exempt student has to complete the 2-credit mandatory course "Research and Publication Ethics (PHS101)".

## Item No. 17.11: Proposal for approval of the disciplinary actions recommended on a student by the student's disciplinary committee (SDC) of the institute.

The matter was also brought to the information of the Dean, Students' Affairs and upon investigation following things were found-

Complaints were received from some of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester students by the office of the Dean (Students affairs), wherein their personal information including photographs were sought by one Diploma 1<sup>st</sup> semester student of Civil Engineering department by the name of an employee of the Central Library of the Institute.

The matter was investigated by the office of the Dean (Students affairs) and finally and brought to the student's disciplinary committee (SDC) of the institute. In a meeting of the SDC, the members unanimously took some resolutions after indepth investigation of the matter and following due procedure. The minutes of the meeting containing details of the incident and the resolutions taken thereof by the SDC was placed before the members.

The resolutions were approved by the competent authority of the institute and recommended to be placed before the Senate for its execution as per the clause no. 4.3.3 of the "Regulation on code of conduct of students" of the institute.

Members were requested to comment and approve the same.

Resolution: The members approved the resolutions suggested by the SDC in principle except resolution no. 4. It was also suggested to explore the relevant legal aspects of the matter with appropriate authorities before executing the resolutions.

### Item No. 17.12: Proposal for awarding Diplomas and Degrees to the 2024 passed out batches of students in the 3<sup>rd</sup> convocation of the institute.

The institute prepared the list of students graduating in 2024 from the Diploma, UG, PG and PhD programmes of the institute. Diplomas and Degrees to these students shall be conferred in the 3<sup>rd</sup> convocation of the institute after the approval of the Board of Governors (BoG). The said list along with the summary statement was placed in the meeting.

Members were requested to approve the proposal.

Resolution: The proposal was approved by the members for placing before the BoG for approval. It was suggested to include the data of all the departments in the summary statement even if no students passed out from that department.

# Item No. 17.13: Approval of the proposal of granting one year leave to a student for joining Job in Government of Bihar during the period of his ongoing B. Tech programme.

Sri Sachin Kumar, a 7<sup>th</sup> semester B. Tech student of Civil Engineering department bearing Roll no 202102012075 has got an opportunity to join against the post of Special Survey Admin (SSA) in the Directorate of Land Records and Survey, Patna under the Government of Bihar as a Diploma candidate. The student had completed Diploma programme under the same department of the institute in 2019. After completion of 1 year of service, he is willing to re-join college again after one year by availing appropriate No objection certificate from the employer to complete the remining years of his programme. In this regard, the student has applied for allowing him to join the referred service.

Considering the referred situation, the institute proposes that leave of one year (and extendable up to two years if required) may be granted to the student.

Members were requested to approve the proposal.

Resolution: The members approved the Proposal for granting 1-year leave (Two semesters) to the student under the condition that the student shall join in the regular service of government of Bihar. However, to continue the studentship, he shall have to pay appropriate semester registration fee during his period of leave as fixed by the competent authority.
